For those students returning or new to QGE in September 2018, students going into grades 1 – 5 will start the year on Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> at 8:30 am. Returning students will meet the teacher they had in June 2019 in the classroom where they ended the school year. Students new to QGE in grades 1 – 5 will meet in the library with Ms. Buehner, Ms. Rogers and Ms. Murdoch Black. Dismissal is at 11:30 am on the first day. Students will meet in these same classes on the second day (Sept 4) as well. Once we have confirmed our enrollment numbers, we will transition students into their new classrooms with new teachers as soon as possible. Our goal is for this transition process to begin on September 4<sup>th</sup>. We will be posting new class lists as soon as we make the transition. Our Kindergarten students have a gradual entry with a series of short meetings between September 3<sup>th</sup> and 10<sup>th</sup>. The first full day for Kindergarten students in Wednesday, September 11<sup>th</sup>.

The school office will be open July 2<sup>nd</sup> to July 4<sup>th</sup> from 8:00 am – 3:00 pm and then re-opens on August 27<sup>th</sup> at 8:00 am. The School Board office is open all summer for emergencies.
